- (4) The fire destroyed thousands of expensive paintings, antiques, and furniture which decorated the condominium.
- (5) Firemen had a great deal of difficulty trying to put out the fire because of the furnishing oil on the furniture, chemicals to preserve the paintings, and alcohol from the bar.
- (6) These chemicals burned very fast and many of them exploded.
- (7) Police think that a cigarette that wasn't put out properly started the fire.
- (8) They are lucky that there were no casualties as everyone was evacuated in time and the people who live on the floor below were out on vacation.
- (9) Fire department investigators told police that the fire seemed to be an accident.
