- (4) The delay has been caused by unusual problems facing census-takers in this large country.
- (5) Some officials traveling in remote areas have to deal with illiteracy.
- (6) Others have been chased away by suspicious villagers who were afraid the census-takers were tax collectors.
- (7) And one large village in western India refuses to give any information at all.
- (8) It seems that many census takers are females; because of tribal beliefs, the leaders won't speak to them.
